# OPENING NINE 30 SECURES 3RD STRAIGHT SCRATCH MATCH PLAY CHAMPIONSHIP FOR MARK POLONCARZ

The finals of the "A" Class Scratch Match Play Championship was expected to be a nip-and-tuck affair between 2 time defending champion Mark Poloncarz and Tom Kozacka. However. Poloncarz took insurmountable lead early on by birdieing the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 5th and 9th holes in shooting a 30 for the opening nine. It was the third consecutive scratch match play title for Poloncarz, and his 5th overall.

Kozaczka made a spirited comeback by recording birdies on the 11th, 14th and 15th holes to stay alive. However, Poloncarz's lead was too much to overcome, and the match ended 3 & 2 with mutual pars

on the 16th hole.

In the semis, Poloncarz had to fight off a hard challenge from Dr. Richard Zambron, while Kozaczka had the come back of the year when he came from 5 down to stun Jim Miller.

#### Tom Quinn Takes "C" Class

Rebounding after his loss in the finals of the President's Cup, Tom Quinn scratched out a hard fought 3 and 2 victory against Mike Kortash in the "C" Class flight. Last year Quinn lost to Kortash in last year's President's Cup final, but this year the hard firing lefty proved too much for Kortash in the end.

Quinn proved to be the best of "C" Class by defeating Rich Klubek, this year's "C" Class 36 hole medal play champ.
